

CO-ED / ADULT / MASTERS TOURNAMENT RULES

CO-ED RULES:

- Minimum of 3 girls' on the court at ALL times. If the team only has 3 girls' and one fouls out, team will play shorthanded. A boy may not substitute for a girl that has fouled out.
- No Backcourt press in the 5th/6th grade Division.
- Boys cannot land in the key on any shot. This will be whistled as a violation, no points awarded and change of possession.
- Boys cannot block a girl's shot. A block is considered any contact with a boy's hands and arms while extended.
 Boy's can contest shots but if the ball contacts hands or arms in the process, it will be considered a blocked shot.
- If a girl is fouled by a boy during the act of shooting, the basket will count regardless of any contact with the ball.
 One free throw and play will resume from the free throw line (make or miss).
- If the teams have custom uniforms, they must also bring a reversible jersey in case of conflicting colors. Home team has choice. Home team is listed on the left side or top of the schedule.
- Awards are limited to a maximum of 10 per team. Rosters may have more than 10 players.

GENERAL RULES:

- Below rules amend NFHS rules.
- Only water allowed in the gyms.
- NO smoking allowed on school premises, violation could lead to expulsion from the tournament.
- NO pets allowed on school premises except for service animals.
- There is an automatic forfeit if a team does not arrive within 10 minutes after the scheduled start of the game.
- An adult 21 years or older must be on the bench at all times to supervise the behavior of the team.
- Twenty (20) minute running time halves, with stop time last fifteen (15) seconds of the first half and last two (2) minutes of the game. NO SHOT CLOCK FOR CO-ED
- 10-second backcourt for ALL DIVISIONS.
- Each team is allowed two (2) thirty second time-outs and two (2) full time outs during regulation play.
- 1st overtime period will be two (2) minutes stop time. 2nd overtime will be sudden death.
 Each team is allowed one (1) full time out in overtime with none to be carried over from regulation.
- 28.5" Ball size used for all divisions
- Absolutely NO "trash talking". Individual's first offense is a 2 shot technical foul. Second offense by the same individual is a 2 shot technical foul and expulsion from the rest of the tournament.
- Fighting: Immediate team(s) forfeiture and expulsion from tournament. Individual(s) and team(s) will be suspended from participating in future Crown City Classic Basketball Tournaments.
- The conduct of players and spectators of your team will be the sole responsibility of your coach. Any misconduct may result in disqualification at the discretion of the referee or gym director, with or without a warning.

- Players, coaches or spectators ejected from the gym will not be allowed in or around the gym area and may be restricted to any further participation in the Tournament.
- Teams are responsible for cleaning their own bench area after the game.

MEN / WOMEN / MASTERS RULES:

- All games consist of two 20-minute running halves. The
 last 15 seconds of the FIRST half will be stop time. The
 last 2 minutes of the SECOND HALF/OT will be stop time
 unless the point spread is 15 points or more. If the point
 spread becomes 15 points or less during the last 2
 minutes of the game, the game will be conducted as stop
 time
- Each team will be allowed 3 time-outs per game.
- Shot clock upon request.
 - Men/Masters 35 seconds
 - Womens 30 seconds
- Technical fouls are counted as personal fouls and team fouls. The opposing team receives two free throws and the ball out of bounds at division line.
- Bonus free throws (1 and 1) on the 7th team foul and 2 shots (double bonus) on the 10th team foul in any half. A player is fouled out on his or her 5th personal foul and may not return to the game.
- If there is a tie at the end of regulation, there will be a **2-minute** overtime. If there is still a tie there will be a "sudden death" situation, the first team to score will be the winner. If it is a championship game, there will be 2 O.T.s before a sudden death. Each team will receive an additional full time out for the overtime & sudden death (all timeouts unused in regulation will carry over).
- Awards for Adult and Masters Awards Individual awards will be given to the Championship, 2nd Place, 3rd Place and Consolation in an 8-team bracket. Championship, 2nd Place, and Consolation in a 6-team bracket and Championship and 2nd place in a 4-team bracket.

<u>Tournament Committee has the right to move teams up</u> <u>or down as they see fit</u>

TIE BREAKER RULES:

For 4-team and 6-team brackets:

- 1. Head to Head
- 2. Point differential in all games played. (highest point differential credit per game is 15 points for sportsmanship reasons).
 - a) Upon determination of the 1st place team, the remaining two or three teams will go through the above scenario until there is a 2nd or 3rd place winner.
